Credit Cards:

Warm and sunny year-round, with an average of 27°C in Colombo. Hill country Climate:

districts are generally around 10°C cooler. The best time to visit the west, south and Central Highlands is October to March, after the southwest monsoon, while the East Coast is best between May and

September.

What to wear: Lightweight cotton or linen clothing.
