

ADVENTURE TOURISM CATEGORY INTRODUCTION

Adventure Tourism Activities:

“All tourism activities that include excitement through both hardcore and softcore adventure tourism activities in physical, natural, and cultural environments based on air, land, and water”.

Air Based Activities:

“Air-based adventure tourism activity” means an activity carried out in the air with adequate safety requirements in an exclusively demarcated area without posing any danger or causing pollution to the natural environment. This may include skydiving, paragliding, paramotoring, hot air ballooning, and other similar activities.”

1	Skydiving	Skydiving is an air-based adventure tourism activity, defined as the descent of a person to the surface from an aircraft in flight with the use of a parachute during all or part of descent.
2	Paragliding	Paragliding is an air-based adventure tourism activity, wide canopy resembling a parachute is attached to a person's body by a harness in order to allow them to glide through the air after jumping from or being lifted to a height.
3	Para Motoring	Paramotoring is an air-based adventure tourism activity, flying through the air wearing a piece of equipment consisting mini engine driven by a propeller connected to a parachute.
4	Hot Air Ballooning	Hot Air Ballooning is an air-based adventure tourism activity, a large balloon with a basket underneath in which tourist can travel while experiencing an excitement. The balloon is filled with hot air in order to make it float in the air.

Water Based Activities:

“Water-based Adventure Tourism activity” means - an activity carryout in inland, brackish & marine water with adequate safety requirements in an exclusively demarcated area without any danger or pollution to the natural environment. This may include Whale & Dolphin Watching, White Water Rafting, Canoeing & Kayaking, Dragon Boating, Scuba Diving /Snorkeling, Surfing/Body Boarding/paddle Boarding, Kite Surfing/Wind Surfing and other similar activities.

1	Kite Surfing/Kite Boarding & Wind Surfing	Kitesurfing/Kiteboarding & Wind Surfing are a water-based adventure tourism activities, combining aspects of wakeboarding, skateboarding, windsurfing surfing, into one extreme sport.
2	Whale & Dolphin Watching	Whale and dolphin watching is a water-based adventure tourism activity, as an umbrella term for close range observation of Whales, Dolphins, porpoises, and Sea Dugongs.

3	Rafting/White Water Rafting	Rafting/White water rafting is a water-based adventure tourism activity which use an inflatable raft to navigate in a river or other water body. This is often done on white water or different degrees (rapids) of rough water.
4	Surfing/Body Boarding/paddle Boarding	Surfing/Body Boarding/paddle Boarding are water-based adventure tourism activities, different types of surf boards are used for all three activities with different techniques. It includes the disciplines of Short Boarding, Long Boarding, Body boarding, Knee Boarding and, Paddle Boarding. Surfing demands body balance and degree of physical fitness.
5	Leisure Boat/ Small Vessel Operations	Leisure Boat/ Small Vessel Operations are water-based adventure tourism activities engaged in leisure travels by using powerboats, sailboats, or man-powered vessels.
6	Scuba Diving /Snorkeling	Both Scuba Diving /Snorkeling are water-based adventure tourism activities that will carry a tourists' excitement in underwater exploration.
7	Water Skiing /Wakeboarding	Water Skiing/ Wakeboarding are water-based adventure tourism activities filled by full of tourists' excitement on the surface of water pulled behind an engine powered boat or towed by a cable ski installation over a water body,
8	Sport Fishing	Sport fishing is water-based adventure tourism activity, popular boat based recreational activity defined as Fresh water fishing (inland water bodies), Brackish water fishing (estuaries), Salt water fishing (sea).
9	Rowing	Rowing is water-based adventure tourism activity that involves tourists' excitement of racing boats using oars. It differs from paddling sports in that rowing oars are attached to the boat using oarlocks, while paddles are not connected to the boat. Rowing is divided into two disciplines: sculling and sweep rowing.
10	Sailing	Sailing is water-based adventure tourism activity specifically refers to the sport of using wind to power sails and propel the boat forward (rather than engines). Unlike windsurfing and surfing, the sport takes place in an enclosed boat rather than on a board. There are two types of sailing – racing and cruising. Racing is the branch of yachting you will recognize from the Olympics; however, cruising is probably what most people would enjoy on their holidays.
11	Canoeing & Kayaking, Dragon Boating	Canoeing & Kayaking, Dragon Boating are water-based adventure tourism activities refers to a group of water sports that require a paddle to propel and steer a vessel through and across the flat water, white water, or ocean.

12	Jet Skiing	Jet Skiing is water-based adventure tourism activity that involves tourists' excitement using a Jet Ski to travel across water
13	House Boating	House boating is water-based adventure tourism activity which involves sailing accommodation with adequate facilities cruise along the lakes, rivers, cannels, or lagoon network.
